### Continuing Business:

- Approve minutes from last meeting
  - Kaitlin Brigman motion to approve - Mathew Toone second – all members present approved minutes

### New Business:

1. Review SAGE Data, PACE and School Grading information
  - a. Language – 58%, Math – 69%, Science – 68%
  - b. We are above the average compared to other schools in the district.
  - c. We are trying to focus on student who fall in the low SES range and students with disabilities.
  - d. Students demonstrated a lot of growth over the last year in Language Arts
  - e. Students demonstrated the most growth in Math
  - f. There was also an improvement in Science, but not as much as the other areas
  - g. PACE/SFAR
    - i. Goal is to have 90% proficiency in 3<sup>rd</sup> grade reading
    - ii. SFAR focuses on growth (300 pts.) and achievement (300 pts.) – there is a total of 600 points the school can earn in this grading system
    - iii. Growth is determined by comparing the previous year scores and the current year SAGE results and rank students by the scale score they earn.
    - iv. Based on all of the test results, Alta View received a “B” letter grade. We improved 2% from last year and are right on the line to jump into an A score.
2. Reviewed Current CSIP plan for 2017-18

3. Review Baseline School Data

a. Fall DIBELS Data (Proficiency %)

- i. K = 78%
- ii. 1<sup>st</sup> = 62%
- iii. 2<sup>nd</sup> = 64%
- iv. 3<sup>rd</sup> = 81%
- v. 4<sup>th</sup> = 58%
- vi. 5<sup>th</sup> = 52%

4. Notification of expenditures from the cell tower budget

- a. Ten percent of cell tower money from other schools is taken and distributed to the schools who do not have a cell tower. The distribution is according to student enrollment. Alta View receives about \$2000/year
- b. This money is used to: maintain the school website, student prizes, teacher needs
